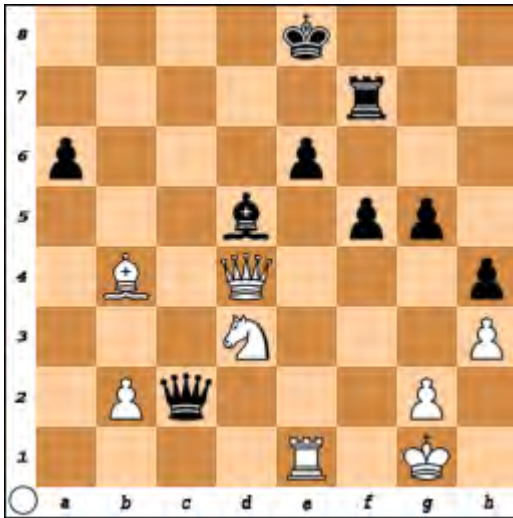


A grandmaster in the making.



Alex Ostrovskiy from New York is only 13 years old, but he can claim a grandmaster as one of his victims over the chess board. Alex defeated two-time US Open champion Sergey Kudrin at a chess tournament held at Marshall Chess Club in Manhattan. Position below is before Alex's final move of the game, after which the 50-year-old Kudrin resigned. See if you can guess Alex's (white) last move. Answer at the bottom.



Answer: white queen simply catches the bishop, since pawn on e6 can't recapture, because it's pinned.
